All adult counselors are responsible for the group's behavior and participation in all activities. All shall abide by the UMYF covenant of conduct signed earlier in the year. It is important for your safety and the safety of others that these guidelines be followed during the mission trip week:

1. No illegal drugs, alcohol or tobacco, or firearms.
2. No leaving the group, sleeping or work area without notifying an adult. No cohabitation.
3. Shoes must be worn at all times when outside-except on beach.
4. When leaving a church, it should be in better condition that when we arrived.
5. All vehicles should be cleaned up nightly and returned in better condition.
6. All CD players or similar must remain locked in the vehicles, but may be used if headphones are used and volume is low in vehicles.
7. No gambling while playing cards.
8. Observe and abide by daily Schedule
9. Sanctuary is only for worship.
10. You will be encouraged to mix with others in the group. The trip is also a time to get to know others better.
11. **Seat belts must be worn properly at all times.**
12. Everything we do is shared. Therefore, everyone will be asked to help with KP duty before and after meals if necessary.
13. Evening, and one morning devotion, will be the group's responsibility.
14. This is a work camp experience, so participants are expected to work and support one another.
15. Anything that is broken will be replaced through the UMYF checking account, unless the adult leadership finds reason to have those who are specifically responsible for replacing or repairing the damage. Respect and kindness for others is expected at all times.
16. When away from the group, you will be asked to stay in groups of at least three with one adult minimum per group.

I have read and understand the above guidelines and agree to abide by them to the best of my ability. I understand that lack of compliance can result in being sent home at my parent's expense (or my own in case of adult).
